- + Computer Enhanced

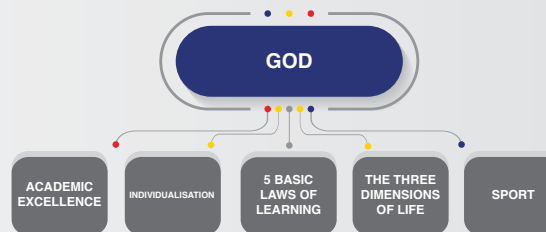
Each child is a unique person, endowed by God with a certain individual talent. He/She is born with a distinctive purpose which only he/she can fulfill to glorify God.

Basic System of Education - Cambridge (Grade 8 -12)

Our Cambridge Pathway is for students aged 11 to 19. It's wide range of subjects and flexibility gives schools the chance to shape the curriculum so that it is exciting and relevant for their own students.

Cambridge Pathway students have the chance to acquire the knowledge and skills they need to achieve at school, university and beyond.

The four stages lead seamlessly from primary to secondary and pre-university years. Each stage - **Cambridge Primary, Lower Secondary, Cambridge Upper Secondary and Cambridge Advanced** - builds on the learners' development from the previous one, but can also be offered separately.



Academic Excellence

Skill and mastery of the basics is the traditional method of learning. The spiral of learning, around which School of Tomorrow is written, brings the students back to previous concepts for drill and reinforcement. The spiral insures that the child not only "gets it" but that he will also retain it.

School of Tomorrow offers individualized core curriculum with a scope of preschool through college preparatory levels in Math, English, Social Studies, Science and Word Building (Etymology for level 8 & 9). Additional, stand alone education software for enhancement courses, academic electives, and learning to read programmes are installed.

Individualisation
